




## Pioneers of the Pacific Coast: A Chronicle of Sea Rovers & Fur Hunters

In the 17th century, British Captain Vancouver meets with Spanish Captain Quadra at Nootka Sound to decide who owns the Pacific Coast. All these explorers risked their lives to find out whether this perilous land was worthy of settlement.
