Excerpt from Preliminary Report of the Secretary of Agriculture, 1899 Sir: In compliance with the requirements of sections 2, 3 and G of the act of March 13, 1895, I have the honor herewith to present the fourth annual report of the Department of Agriculture, over which you have placed me in control. The act of the Legislature of March 13, 1895, establishing a Department of Agriculture for the State, provided for the distribution of the work into five distinct Divisions, viz: Farmers Institutes, Dairy and Food Inspection, Economic Zoology, Forestry and a Veterinary Division. No separate divisions were established for the control of Commercial Fertilizer Inspections, or for Special Scientific Investigations and Examinations, also provided for in the law. The Secretary has, accordingly, assumed direct charge of these two important lines of work, in addition to his general supervision of the various Divisions, which make up the Department. The present Secretary, in taking charge of the Department after his appointment, April 26th of this year, found that a number of important subjects connected with our agricultural...
