

THE FALLACIES OF ATHEISM

The proponents of the new atheism have adopted a debating strategy of insisting upon material proof for the existence of God while refusing to accept a definition of the word God upon which people of faith through the ages would be able to agree. The author demonstrates that such a definition makes the existence of God a truism and therefore that atheism itself is fallacious, either by a false definition to advance an argument -- the straw man fallacy -- or by defying logic in asserting the negation of a truism. From other aspects of what should be considered the mislabeled new atheism, the author then suggests the more appropriate label of materialism. The author then shows the fallacies in materialism and the material court, the latter being the venue of the material proof demanded by the new atheists, so-called. That discussion then leads to a presentation of a simple metaphysical framework, in which can be conducted more constructive debates as to one aspect of the nature of God. This metaphysical framework is then applied to a falsely attributed social flaw presented by the new atheists, showing that flaw to be based on a fallacy which deceives the public. Other social criticisms of the new atheists also point out common fallacies which have deceived the public, leading to disastrous results. Rational people of religious and irreligious persuasion can find common cause in lifting the veil of deception by pointing out these fallacies. It should be pointed out that the authors willingness to consider the truth behind the patently false allegations of the new atheists is what he refers to as not showing bias against everything the new atheists say or write. It is, by definition, unreasonable for the author not to biased against...
