He was a pianist, a teacher and a composer. He developed several musical ways such as programmatic music, technique and thematic transformation. He traveled most of his life, and composed a number of works about the places that he traveled. He met his first lover, Countess Marie dAgoult at the end of 1832, and they had three children, Blandine, Cosima and Daniel. Liszt separated from Countess Marie dAgoult in 1844, and he had met his second beloved one who took a very important role for Liszts life, Princess Carolyne in 1847. His only son died at age of twenty-one in 1859, and three years later, his elder daughter Blandine died at the age of twenty-six after giving birth to her first child. Liszts only surviving daughter, Cosima left her husband, Hans von Blow in order to live with Richard Wagner. These three children are from Countess Marie...
