Department of Commerce and the Government of the Peoples s Republic of China agreed, effective August 2, to restrict the volume of Chinese honey exports to the United States. The agreement replaces punitive u.s. Anti-dumping duties on honey from China with quantitative and price limits on Chinese honey shipments to the United States. Under the 5-year agreement, China will be allowed to export about tons of honey yearly to the United States. Chinese honey must be sold at or above a reference price equivalent to 92 percent of the average quarterly per unit value of imports from all other countries. U.s. Imports of Chinese honey increased steadily from tons in 1989 to a record tons in 1993. Imports in 1994 totaled tons. In response to a petition from the Armorican Beekeeping Federation, the us. Department of Commerce instituted an anti-dumping investigation on imports of honey from China on March 20, 1995. Us. Orange juice exports are running at a record pace. Record u.s. Orange juice production will offset lower Brazilian output in keeping worldwide supplies...
