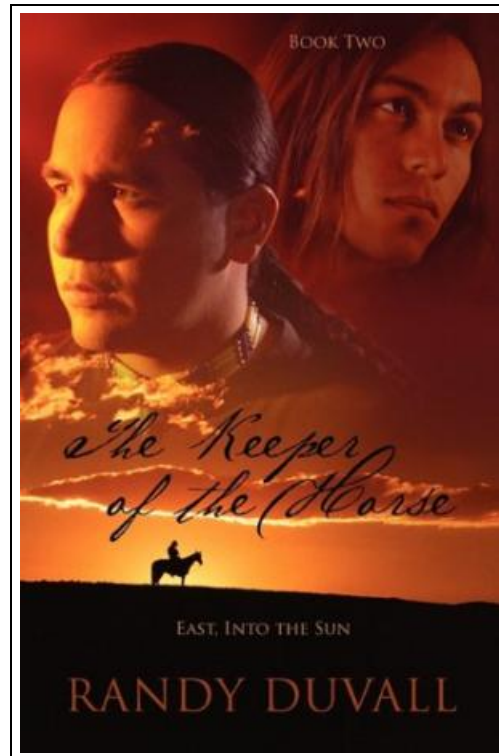

Slowly the first know Europeans, the Spanish, had established themselves mainly south of the Rio Grande, to California, and along the southern coast to Florida, but for the most part, their expansion had ceased. Their goal was not settlement, but finding wealth. In 1770, with the signing of the Treaty of Paris, France ceded lands to Spain that included the Mississippi river port of Saint Louis and west for compensation of the British being forfeited Florida. At this time Spain was the most influential European nation in North America. Her grip on the New World was formidable but she lacked the finances to take full advantage of her holdings. Spain was satisfied with the discovery of precious ores of Gold, Silver, Copper and Lead, as well as the variety of fruits, vegetables and spices that flourished in abundance in Central America. Spanish entrepreneurs, Ranchers, and the Catholic Church made up the bulk of their colonists. Their Military presence, for the most part, was solely that of protector. France, after the Seven Years War or French and Indian war, with England, by treaty, officially ceased to exist in North America. Because of centuries of settlement and exploration, the French heritage and influence remained strong. France s main focus was the valuable fur trade, but after the war with Britain, the trappers and Coeur De Bois still trapped - but for the British. England, at this time, was the most power country in the world. She had colonies in India, northern Africa, the West Indies, Hawaii, as well...
