We cannot explain the electric and magnetic inductions in the sense of giving the rationale of their production by a mechanical system, but this may not be because we know less of thiags electric and magnetic than we do of the ordinary dynamical action of material systems, but because the explanation of electrical phenomena must be sought in the solution of those very difficulties which...
