




Taming the Nueces Strip: The Story of McNellys Rangers

Their main objective To steal cattle, which they herded back across the Rio Grande to sell. Honest citizens found it almost impossible to live in the Nueces Strip. In desperation, the governor of Texas called on an extraordinary man, Captain Leander M. McNelly, to take command of a Ranger company and stop these border bandits. One of McNellys recruits for this task was George Durham, a Georgia farmboy in his teens when he joined the Little McNellys, as the Captains band called themselves. More than half a century later, it was George Durham, the last surviving McNelly Ranger, who recounted the exciting tale of taming the Nueces Strip to San Antonio writer Clyde Wantland.
