


## Secret Yankees: The Union Circle in Confederate Atlanta

Drawing upon a little-known diary by Cyrena Bailey Stone, Dyer's history recounts how a small but dedicated band of Northern sympathizers risked their lives to assist Yankee prisoners and runaway slaves, while also providing scouting information to William Tecumseh Sherman's advancing army. The book's appendix includes the complete text of Stone's witty and often poetic diary, which she thinly fictionalized to safeguard the identities of the members of her group. 384.
