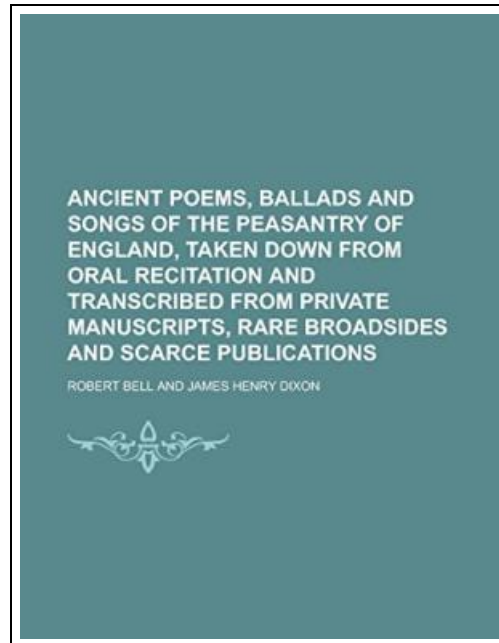

The Felon Sewe belongs to the same class of compositions as the Hunting of the Hare, reprinted by Weber, and the Townsmen of Totenkam, in Percys Reliques. comic romance was a sort of parody upon the usual subjects of THE FELON SEWE OF ROKEBY. although they have not descended to us. to have met with an old chivalric romance, in which the leading incidents were similar to those of the Felon Sewe. It may be observed, also, in reference to this poem, that the design is twofold, the ridicule...
